



CONTROLLED PIT STOPS:

1. Controlled Pit Stops will be utilized, where no car will lose positions in regard to other cars that pit under the same caution period, and teams will have **three laps to service** their car during a caution period, unless declared a 'Quickie Yellow', which will be when a simple caution occurs. If you pit on a Quickie Yellow, you may not get a full three laps to service your car.
2. Only the first caution lap (on the leader) will be counted during each caution period. During the time the caution laps are no longer counting, and once the "Pits are Open" is when you can enter pit lane and conduct your "Controlled Pit Stop", where you will have up to three laps to service your car, fuel, tires, etc., without losing positions in relation to other cars that pit under the same caution period. If you do not pit when the pits open and decide to the next lap you will lose your position.
3. All work must be done and back on track before pace car gets to designated spot at the end of the third lap of the Controlled Pit Stop.
4. If you enter pit lane before the "Pits are Open", you will restart at the tail of the field.
5. If a green flag run goes 50 laps without a caution, a 'Competition Yellow' will be displayed on the 50th lap of consecutive green flag racing. This will not apply within the final 15 laps of the race.
6. For the race you will be allowed a total of eight (8) tires, four (4) qualifiers and four (4) tires to change during a Controlled Pit Stop during the race. These (4) four tires must be your approved race tires and will remain impounded until race time – you may fuel and change all (4) four during (1) Controlled Pit Stop.
7. The pits will be "closed" once the yellow flag is displayed and will stay closed until opened by Race Control.
8. The Stop 'n' Go Sign at the end of the pit road must be observed. Pit lane speed will be enforced.
9. You must stay behind Pace Car at all times, do not move ahead of the Pace Car.
